RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council authorize and direct the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement for public relations and communications services with Spaulding Thompson and Associates for a period of one year, with two optional one-year extensions with a not-to-exceed amount as described in the fiscal impact section.
