PARKWAY LANDSCAPING GUIDELINES

PARKWAYS DEFINED *DPMC 14.01.010* The area between the roadway and the property line adjacent thereto. Uses of the parkway include, but are not limited to landscaping, street trees, sidewalks public statuary, bus benches and bus shelters, street lights, traffic signals, fire hydrants, and City authorized signage. *DPMC 6.14.002* Any front yard, parkway, or landscaped setback area which lacks turf, other planted material, decorative rock, bark or planted ground cover or covering, so as to cause excessive dust or allow the accumulation of debris.

ALTERNATIVES PER MUNICIPAL CODE 14.01.610:



Replace grass with drought tolerant grass (e.g. Hall's or Seashore Bentgrass, UC Verde Buffalograss, Dymondia, Zoysia or other native grasses) and/or replace sprinkler irrigation system with subsurface irrigation. No Encroachment Permit Required



Installation of artificial turf by licensed contractor. Encroachment Permit Required

Option 3

Install a combination of predominantly lowlying drought tolerant plants with intermittent connected walkway space (plant height not to exceed 36 inches). Encroachment Permit Required

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS:

- Planting Plan as accepted by Water District
- □ Standard Maintenance Agreement (provided by City of Dana Point)
